We are very sorry to have to report that there have again been no applicants for the position of Rector here.

Fire Doors

The fire doors in the hall are in need of urgent attention. They will open in an emergency, but closing them again is hard and there is a nasty step out which is a trip hazard. To lower the door, to eliminate the step, will be a big job and will need new doors. This will cost upwards of £3,000. The snag is that there is no money in the fabric fund for this work – given that we also need to have the chancel roof attended to which will be nearly £4,000 to complete.
